## CHIEF RETURNING OFFICER REFERENDUM REPORT

Dear Scarborough Campus Community Radio,

The 2016 referendum voting for the Scarborough Campus Community Radio Incorporated to increase their levy from \$4.85 to \$12.85 commenced on Friday September 30<sup>th</sup> with polling taking place from 10 am to 5 pm in the BV building, and continued on Monday September 3<sup>rd</sup> during the same time and in the same place. The students were asked one question to determine their support.

A student master list was obtained from the University of Toronto's Department of Student Life to verify voter eligibility prior to polling. The received list was deemed the official voters list. During polling, a list of student names who voted was maintained by the polling clerks to ensure no duplicate votes were made. I verified each student against the list provided by the university. One student could not be verified by this list and my ballot to break a tie was not considered in the results.

All of the SCCR by-law articles were adhered to, and a forum on the SCCR website was created in order to discuss topics relating to the referendum. Notices were sent to the Varsity and Underground publications on campus, and further posts were made the SCCR website and social media accounts, with physical postings of the approved poster on campus bulletin boards.

No complaints or concerns were received regarding the referendum at any point.


